Historical Project Update...

As an update to the School's historical project, the bad news is that due to the State of Illinois budget crisis, the Digital Past collaboration which included our own historical images, along with its host, the North Suburban Library System, has been closed. The good news is that the Illinois State Library has picked up all of the digital image collections from Digital Past and added them to the Illinois Digital Archive (IDA) collection.
