- Graham Hospital School of Nursing signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution intends to use no less than 50 percent of the grant funds awarded herein pursuant to section 2003 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) (Pub. L. 117-2) to students.
- 2. Graham Hospital School of Nursing will receive \$138,008 from the Department, of which at least \$69,004 will be used to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
- 3. \$20,575 of Emergency Financial Aid Grants has been distributed to students under Section 2003 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) as of August 18, 2021. A total of \$73,067 has been distributed to students from HEERF I and HEERF II funds as of March 31, 2021.
- 4. An estimated 63 students at the institution are eligible to participate in programs under Section 2003 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) (Pub. L. 117-2) as of August 17, 2021 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
- 5. A total of 0 students has received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under Section 2003 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) (Pub. L. 117-2) during the first 30 days.
- 6. The institution will market the availability of the funds to all students and establish the method by which it will determine how much each would receive in HEERF III Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section 2003 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) (Pub. L. 117-2). The first draw down of grant funds has occurred within 90 days of the Grant Award Notification.
- 7. The institution has established instructions, directions, and/or guidance concerning the grants and distributed them to students on July 31, 2021, in coordination with #6 above.
