# **UPDATES** from the Graham Health System

Graham is doing well. Graham Health System continues to expand their market in Galesburg. They will close in early February on a building that will be utilized as a five day a week outpatient clinic. Work is progressing on the new Galesburg GMG/Outpatient Center on Seminary Street (close to shopping center where super Walmart, Menards, Kohls, and other smaller shops are located). Anticipated opening is August 1, 2024.

Graham Health System is financially strong and continues to experience high volumes. All clinics are busy and the system continues to grow.

The Board is interviewing candidates for the COO position (Chief Operating Officer). This person will move up to the CEO position when the current President, Bob Senneff, retires next year.

### News from the School

Graduation for the Class of 2024 will be held on Saturday, May 11, at 10:00 a.m. at Canton High School. Should not have the conflict with scheduled high schools' graduations that we have had in the past. This year, all scholarships will be presented at Graduation so donors and families have the opportunity to be there. Previously, we have given out some at the Senior Recognition Banquet to avoid lengthening the graduation ceremony. The school has been so lucky to have so many scholarships available to students from organizations, past graduates or relatives, and other people that have a relationship or supported the School of Nursing.

The SON continues to progress on the proposal to start a BSN (Bachelor of Science in Nursing) program at Graham Hospital. The first step is to submit the curriculum plan to the Illinois Board of Nursing for approval in March of this year. Graham Hospital Association (Charter date 1909), already has the ability to grant a degree because the school is older than the Illinois Department of Higher Education. The State refers to this situation as being "grandfathered in". The SON does need to get Board of Nursing approval of their BSN curriculum plans and hours. They will probably start with a 2+2 type plan where the general education courses are taken before the nursing courses. A lot of current students have already completed most or all of the support general education classes.

The next step would be getting accreditation from the ACEN (Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing). Our diploma program is currently accredited by the ACEN. The BSN is a <u>new</u> program, and is not technically just changing the current diploma program so a lot of work to be done. The SON has discussed this idea many times in the past, but our admissions remained stable. Admissions have declined the past few years and it is hard to recruit students that do not understand the benefits of a three-year education with additional clinical experiences, but receiving a diploma instead of a degree. The school is trying some new ways to recruit students. Shelby Boster, Coordinator of Student Affairs, reported that the School of Nursing hosted 26 junior and senior students from Canton Senior High School this past October. That is a great turnout. This is a lot of information to understand, but I am sure that a lot of thought and consideration has occurred.

#### Transcript Requests....

We get many calls asking "What do I have to do to request a transcript?". There are a few ways to go about requesting a transcript:

- 1. Print the transcript request form found on the school's website. The form can be found under the Quick Links tab on the top bar menu or the Alumni tab at the bottom of the home page. Fill out the form and mail to us with the \$5.00 fee.
- 2. Email Shelby Boster (<a href="mailto:sboster@grahamhospital.org">sboster@grahamhospital.org</a>) with your request. Be sure to include the year you graduated and where you need the transcript sent. You may mail your \$5.00 or pay by phone with the hospital cashier (309-647-5240 ext. 2221).
- 3. Stop by the school office to fill out the request form and pay the fee. Transcripts typically are mailed out within 1 or 2 days of the request.
