

UPDATES from the Graham Health System

Graham is doing well. Graham Health System continues to expand their market in Galesburg. Work is progressing on the new Galesburg GMG/Outpatient Center on Seminary Street (close to shopping center where super Walmart, Menards, Kohls, and other smaller shops are located). Anticipated opening is August 1, 2024.

Graham Health System is financially strong and continues to experience high volumes. All clinics are busy and the system continues to grow.

The Hospital Board has finished candidate interviews for the COO position (Chief Operating Officer). All Sours, a current vice president at Graham, has accepted the position of COO. This person will move up to the CEO position when the current President, Bob Senneff, retires next year.

News from the School

The SON received approval from the Illinois Board of Nursing to start a BSN (Bachelor of Science in Nursing) program. Graham Hospital Association (Charter date 1909), already has the ability to grant a degree. The first classes (nursing courses) will start in the fall of 2025. It will be a 2+2 curriculum plan where all the general education courses required are taken first before the nursing courses. A lot of current students have already completed most or all of the support general education classes. There will be students in both programs next fall.

The diploma program will continue as a separate program until it is feasible to discontinue it and just offer the BSN.

The next step would be getting accreditation from the ACEN (Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing). Our diploma program is currently accredited by the ACEN. The BSN is a <u>new</u> program, and is not technically just changing the current diploma program so a lot of work to be done.


ALUMNI NEWS:

Transcript Requests....

We get many calls asking "What do I have to do to request a transcript?". There are a few ways to go about requesting a transcript:

- 1. Print the transcript request form found on the school's website. The form can be found under the Quick Links tab on the top bar menu or the Alumni tab at the bottom of the home page. Fill out the form and mail to us with the \$5.00 fee.
- 2. Email Shelby Boster (sboster@grahamhospital.org) with your request. Be sure to include the year you graduated and where you need the transcript sent. You may mail your \$5.00 or pay by phone with the hospital cashier (309-647-5240 ext. 2221).
- Stop by the school office to fill out the request form and pay the fee. Transcripts typically are mailed out within I or 2 days of the request.
